NV. Sussex, England

Nyetimber are located in West Sussex, and have established themselves as England's premier sparkling wine house, making world class wines to rival (and often beat in blind tastings) the big names of Champagne. Lovely pale gold and gentle, fine bubbles. Toasty, spicy and complex aromas showing wonderful development after more than three years on lees in the cellar.

The palate supports these complex aromas with honey, almond, pastry and baked apple flavours.

Very fine and elegant with a great combination of intensity, delicacy and length.

Arc du Rhône is named after the classified group of villages which together line up to form a geographical arc across the valley of the southern Rhône and is known locally as the 'arc of gold'

This Côtes du Rhône Villages is typically full-flavoured, lusciously fruity with a delicate spice in the finish; made with subtle oak maturation principally from Grenache Noir and Syrah with some enriching Carignan.
