**Les Sauvagères
Paul Jaboulet Aîné
Saint-Peray France 2015**

Bottle 19.95

A Northern Rhone white wine, Les Sauvagères is the local name for Marsanne in Saint-Peray, implying the wild tendency of the vines to dig into the steep limestone of this tiny town. A pure, fresh, mineral style, floral and fruity on the nose, the palate being slightly creamy/buttery with good hints of vanilla. Aromas of lemon curd, green apple and jasmine. Dry and taut in the mouth, offering brisk citrus and orchard fruit flavors.

Rich and opulent Grand Cru gewürztraminer at a great price. Medium sweet with potent aromas of tropical fruit. Spicy and fresh on the palate. A pretty stunning wine we think. Too good to miss.
